Admissions Fee:

- Includes application and testing fees
- Non-refundable

Matriculation Fee:

- Due on May 1st for all returning students through the FACTS Tuition Management Plan
- Due with admissions fee for new students
- Non-refundable
- Non-payment by due date will result in student being removed from the class roster

Tuition Payments:

- Includes testing, curriculum book rental/fees, yearbook, school pictures (1st- 11th grades), field trips (two per year- Kindergarten- 5th grade only), assignment notebooks (if applicable), graduation packages (Kindergarten and Seniors only)
- Non-payment of fees will result in the student not being allowed to attend class
- All payments must be made through FACTS Tuition Management Plan
- Families are required to enroll in FACTS; manual payments will not be accepted at the school
- **There is a \$41 non-refundable annual fee to set up payments with FACTS**
- Information regarding the FACTS process can be found on Edline or on the CCS website
- **Payment in Full***- payment in full by June 1st. Accounts not paid in full by June 1st will be billed on one of the payment plan options. Students enrolled after June 1st may receive the Annual Payment discount if tuition is paid in full at the time of acceptance.
- **Payment Plan****- first tuition payment due in either July (11-month plan) or August (10-month plan) and the last payment due in May.

After-School

- Fee for use of the After-School program is \$40.00 per week per student
- Offered only to full-day students from dismissal – 6:30 p.m.
- Fees will apply to any student signed in by the teacher for any day of the week
- There is a \$2.00 per minute charge for anyone picked up after 6:30 p.m.
- Non-payment of fees will result in the student not being allowed to attend the program
- Calendar break weeks are available for an additional fee and with prior registration
- Early Arrival, 7:00-7:45 a.m., is free of charge

Discounts

- **Community Bible Church Qualified Active Member Discount**
 - Applies to yearly school tuition
 - Yearly application and approval required
 - Application available in school office
 - \$600 per year for full-time students
 - \$400 per year for part-time student
- **Multi-child Discount**
 - Applies to yearly school tuition
 - Each child must be within the same family with the same parent paying
 - Second Child \$300
 - Third Child \$420
 - Fourth Child \$600

Late Fee

- All payments are due on the 1st, 10th, or 16th of each month as arranged with FACTS
- Late or missed payments due to insufficient funds will be assessed a \$50.00 late fee (\$25 assessed by FACTS and \$25 assessed by CCS)
- Missed payments will be automatically reattempted by FACTS

Waiting List Fee

- In the event a class is full, families may ask to be placed on the waiting list until a space becomes available
- The fee (\$50) will be applied to the admissions fee if an opening becomes available
- Non-refundable

Auxiliary Charges

- Additional charges incurred, including but not limited to the following, will be billed separately from the tuition rates:
 - After-School, lunch, sports, Middle/High School field trips, Speech Therapy, NILD, Search and Teach, or library charges
- Charges (excluding lunch charges) will be billed on a monthly basis and will be due with monthly tuition
- Lunch charges will be billed separately
- Non-payment of fees will result in the student not being allowed to attend class
- All payments will be made through FACTS Tuition Management

Withdrawals

- Admissions Fees, Matriculation Fees, Waiting List Fees, and the first and second month's tuition are non-refundable
- Tuition is due through the end of the month for which the student attends school
- A withdrawal fee of \$500.00 will be due at the time of withdrawal
- Student records will not be released until 10 business days after the last payment is made on the student's account
- Overpayments on accounts will be processed within two to four weeks

Financial Assistance

Each year, the Financial Assistance Committee of CCS allocates a limited amount of budgetary funds to assist qualifying families. To qualify for assistance, students must maintain a clean academic record and be in good behavioral standing with the principal's office. In order to determine financial eligibility, the family must apply with FACTS Tuition Management which evaluates applications and makes recommendations back to the committee as to qualification. Recommendations from FACTS are evaluated without regard to race, age, or sex of the applicant family. Applications for assistance will be accepted beginning February 15th. Assistance is limited and applications should be submitted by February 28th.

Late Admissions

- Students enrolling after July 1st will need to speak with the Student Accounts office for payment options
- Students beginning school between the 1st and 15th of any month will be billed for the entire month
- Students beginning between the 16th and the last day of the month will be billed an amount equal to half of the Standard Payment Plan tuition rate
